String Straw Bead Necklace	Cut up pastel colored paper straws into 1-2 inch pieces. Use them as beads to thread onto long string. Make patterns, match colors, and practicing counting beads as they are threaded to make necklaces and bracelets.	• Paper Straws • Lacing String	• Thread Beads • Make Patterns • Count Objects
Wet Chalk/Ease Easter Eggs	Print an egg outline on cardstock. Add a few strips of washi tape to make lines of water or patterns. Dip into a cup of water and color each section of the egg. Peel the tape off to reveal your design.	• Egg Outline (up 8) • Washi Tape • Chalk • Water	• Color with Chalk • Peel Tape
Roll from Easter Egg Hatching	Print egg outlines on cardstock. Use pom poms onto cardstock to use as brushes. Dip pom poms into paint to stamp, stamp, spin and decorate Easter egg.	• Egg Outline (up 8) • Pom Poms • Chalk • Cardstock • Permanent Paint	• Make Stamps • Paint
Open a New Hatching Egg to Use as Stamps	Open a new hatching egg to use as stamps. Press the cracks into layers of white cardstock. Roll straws into past to stamp, stamp and decorate Easter egg.	• Hatching Eggs • Permanent Paint • Lacing String	• Make Stamps • Paint

SPRING STRAW BEAD NECKLACE

Skills:

- Thread Beads

- Use the cut up straws as beads to thread onto long string.
- Make patterns, match colors, and practicing counting beads as they are threaded to make necklaces and bracelets.

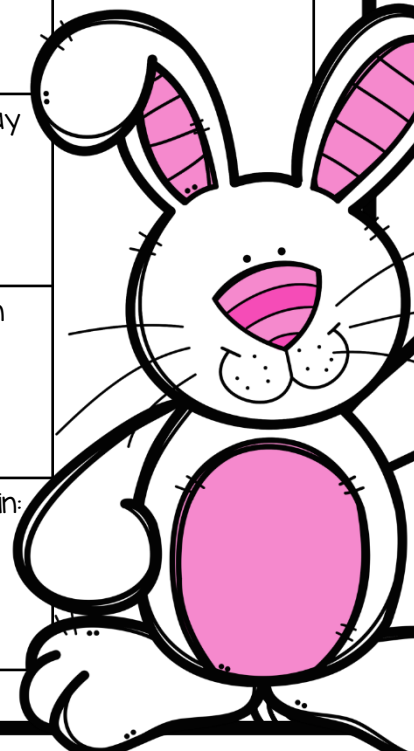
