Ice Cream Letter Writing Tray	Pour sprinkles onto a tray. Free ice cream shop letter cards to use as a model. Use finger or a sugar cone to practice drawing and writing letters. Counting Sprinkles	Print the ice cream counting cards with the numbers 1-5 on each cone. Cut up colored straws to use as sprinkles. Puffy Paint Ice Cream Cones	Cut out the triangle cone from brown paper. Use 2 brushes to paint cream and white dots with equal spacing. Add the other side with blue watercolor. Allow to dry and use fine motor tweezers to add red and pink sprinkles to the paint. Ice Cream Shop	Use flat ice cream pieces to set up an ice cream shop. Make ice cream cones with sprinkles, toppings, and more.	• Scissors • Blue Stick • Ice Cream Cones	• Cut with Scissors • Glue • Make Patterns • Count Objects

COUNTING SPRINKLES

Skills:

- Print the ice cream counting cards with the numbers 1-5 on each cone.
- Cut up colored straws to use as sprinkles.

Directions:

- Use fine motor tweezers to count out the correct number of sprinkles for each cone.
